

Languedoc Facts & Figures

Vineyards & Grape Varieties

- The entire region of Languedoc-Roussillon has 580,000 acres of vineyards
- Languedoc, South of France is France's largest wine region
- Of the total acreage, over 82,000 acres produce AOC Languedoc wines
- There are more than 30 appellations in Languedoc divided amongst the three main tiers of AOC Languedoc, Grands Vins du Languedoc and Crus du Languedoc
- Still wine dominates production in the region, though there are appellations for sparkling wines and sweet vins doux naturels

Production

- Languedoc AOCs produce roughly 1.3 million hectoliters per year
- The AOCs of the Languedoc region account for about 10% of total production
- 30% of all of France's organic viticulture can be found in Languedoc-Roussillon
